## Printing Pictures at Costco

After downloading your original Mark Harris Photography (MHP) digital files from <http://www.markharrisphoto.com>, the next step is to have them printed. Obviously, you can print them at any photo lab of your choice. However, if you have a Costco membership, I *highly* recommend that you have your pictures printed there. Why Costco? I've found that Costco beats the pants off traditional pro photo labs in both quality and price. *As such, it's the only photo lab I use for my print work.*

To print pictures at Costco:

1. Print and take the MHP *Print Release Form* with you - Costco may ask for an official print release. [http://www.markharrisphoto.com/print-release-form--mhphoto\\_standard.pdf](http://www.markharrisphoto.com/print-release-form--mhphoto_standard.pdf)
2. At the Costco kiosk machines, do the following:
  1. Start by inputting your name and phone number at the Costco kiosk machine.
  2. Do one of the following:
    - For the 5"x7" and 8"x10"/8"x12" digital files, tap **Enlargements, Wallets, and Package Prints**. Tap the size of the images you intend to print, and then continue with step 3.
    - For the 4x6 files, tap **Print Selected Pictures At 4x6**, and then continue with step 3.
  3. Tap **Lustre**.
  4. Tap **Borderless**.
  5. Select the files that you want to print.
  6. Tap **No, do not add images to DVD**, unless of course you want that that option.
  7. On the Summary screen, turn off **Auto Correction**.

All MHP digital file are color-corrected and calibrated to the specifications required by the Fuji and Epson printers in use at Costco. Enabling *Auto Correction* will degrade the color fidelity and tonality of your prints.

8. Tap **Check Out**.
